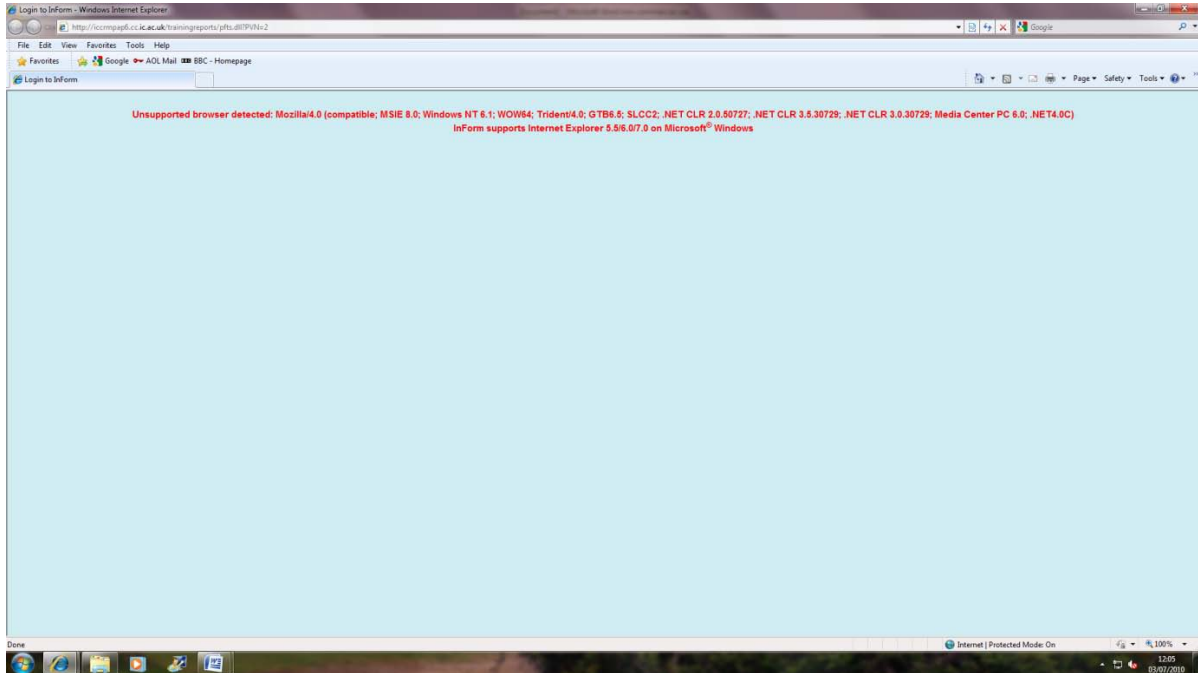


Activating Compatibility View for InForm in Internet Explorer 8

Overview

“Compatibility View” is a mode in Internet Explorer 8 (IE 8) that displays web sites in the same way as Internet Explorer 7 (IE 7). The Compatibility View allows users to browse web content designed for IE 7 while using the new IE 8 browser.

Once your browser has been upgraded to IE8, the first time you try to log into your InForm trial the screen will look as follows:



This guidance describes how to initiate the Compatibility View for the IE 8 browser.

1) Compatibility View Button

In IE 8 users can click a Compatibility View button when attempting to access a site that seems to have compatibility problems. The browser will then redisplay the web page as if it was being shown in IE 7. In addition, IE 8 remembers the url so that next time the user visits that site, they continue to access it in Compatibility View.

Compatibility View is initiated using a button near the Reload and Close buttons at the top of the browser. The button looks like a ripped document as shown below.
